



Know your costs

Here are your benefits at a glance for the HSA plan:

When your doctor prescribes a medication, it will fall into one of these drug tiers. Tiers are a way of explaining how much your prescription will cost.

	1-month supply	3-month supply
Tier 1: Generic, lowest-cost medications	25% (after deductible is met)	25% (after deductible is met)
Tier 2: Preferred brand names, low-cost medications	30% up to a \$125 maximum (after deductible is met)	30% up to a \$312 maximum (after deductible is met)
Tier 3: Non-preferred brand name medications (lower-cost options may be available)	40% up to a \$225 maximum (after deductible is met)	40% up to a \$562 maximum (after deductible is met)
Tier 4: Higher-cost medications (often includes specialty medications for conditions such as cancer, multiple sclerosis or rheumatoid arthritis)	40% up to a \$225 maximum (after deductible is met)	Not Available
